SO YOU THINK YOU WANT TO BE A PILOT?




Welcome aviators to your first day of the Flight Path Explorer brought to you by Flex Air.

Every career pilot's journey starts with an initial flight in a training aircraft. It's in these small, dependable, safe trainers that new pilots learn the motto, "Do the basics. Flawlessly." And before every flight, you inspect your aircraft to make sure it's ready to go. Attention to detail, following checklists, and discipline are our allies. Even the smallest tasks matter.

Today you are going to get your first experience of what being a professional pilot is all about by jumping into the Flex Air Preflight Challenge. The goal of the simulation is to get your aircraft ready for takeoff by completing all of the requirements of the aircraft preflight inspection.

- To get started, open the Flex Air Flight Simulator
- There are two modes for the flight simulator Tutorial Mode and Assessment Mode
- In **Tutorial Mode** you will have a guided walk-through of an aircraft preflight inspection
- In **Assessment Mode** you can challenge yourself to navigate the preflight inspection without any hints or instructions. We recommend starting in tutorial mode to get the hang of it and then you can test your knowledge later on in assessment mode.
- Once you select the mode follow the in-app guidance to perform your pre-flight checklist and get this plane ready for takeoff.

HELPFUL TIPS FOR SUCCESS



- ✓ To Navigate the Simulator on Desktop, use the W-A-S-D Keys for Movement and hold down and drag the right mouse button to situate the camera view.
- ✓ To Navigate the Simulator on Mobile, use the Left On-Screen Joystick for Movement and the Right On-Screen Joystick to situate the camera view.
- ✓ You can track your progress using the checklist on the right hand side of the screen.

Congratulations aviator! You have completed Day 1 of the Flight Path Explorer and successfully finished the Flex Air Flight Simulator. This simulator mimics the same preflight inspection you will do as a Flex Air student, so you are already ahead of the game.




Welcome aviators to your second day of training as a Flight Path Explorer!

DAY 3 FLIGHT PATH EXPLORER

THE PILOT PATHWAY




Congratulations aviators! We have safely reached cruising altitude!

Yesterday, we spent time defining both what you value and the "why" behind why you are looking to pursue an aviation career. Today, we are going to highlight an important part of the Flex Air program that has led to higher student success rates and more well-rounded aviators.

As a pilot looking towards the career track of commercial aviation, it's important that we not only prepare you to understand the technical aspects of flying, but also what it means to be an aviation professional. One of the tools we provide students in navigating their career development is support to perfect their application materials, including their "Tell Me About Yourself" story.

Estimated Time: 30 minutes



Telling a story about yourself is a brief and memorable way of introducing yourself, getting across a key point or two, and making a connection with someone. These connections, also known as networking, can be a scary part of professional life no matter what career you are embarking on. Simple structures, such as the "Tell Me About Yourself" story, can help provide a strategic framework for success.

For today's exercise, we challenge you to begin to craft your personal story. There are many ways to answer a "Tell me about yourself" question. **Let's focus on the question:**

Why Are You Interested in Ariotion?



USE THE FOLLOWING GUIDE TO STRUCTURE YOUR STORY

- Full Power Takeoff: Introduce yourself and tell us who you are and where you are from. Begin your story with a memorable event where you were first inspired by aviation.
- High Level Cruise: Remember yesterday, when we identified the "why" behind your decision to explore flight school. This can be a great way to connect with someone in the industry. Continue your story by linking what happened in your story to your personal "why" and values. Don't get bogged down in details! Keep it at a high level.
- Full Stop Landing: Don't let your story wander. Keep it short and to the point. Conclude with something that you learned about yourself, or what inspires you most about aviation. Extra credit: Keep the conversation going by asking a question: Learn something about the other person. Maybe ask them about a time they were inspired to become a pilot?
- **Be Bold, Be Brief:** Sometimes these "tell me about yourself" introductions are called "Elevator Pitches". Why? Because a typical elevator ride lasts 30 seconds, and that's all the time you might get to make a connection at an airline hiring event. Can you refine your story and get it under 90 seconds at first? Then down to 60 with practice? Then you'll be ready to focus on the essentials, and try your hand at a 30-second version of your story. (What are the essentials you say? Spend more time describing how you felt, instead of what happened).





A great way to practice your story is with either a recording device (zoom, cell phone, tape recorder, etc.) or recruit a friend to listen. Mirrors are less ideal for practicing because vou are unable to garner feedback or rewatch your practice session for self-critique.

NOW IT'S YOUR TURN

Record 2-3 run throughs of your story with a short break in between. Find a quiet space where without practice Maybe try some different variations on to see what might work best. Record these stories as if they were the real thing, get yourself in the mindset for success.

CHECK OUT THIS EXAMPLE

If it helps you to get started, answer the prompt - "So, tell me a little bit about yourself. Why are you interested in aviation?"



TIME TO REFLECT

Once you have locked in your story, re-watch, and provide a self-reflection. Best to always start your reflection with three points where you think you did well and then three points where you might be able to improve in the future.

✓ What to look for in your story reflection - 1) Body language sitting up straight, are you shoulders up and back, and looking at the camera. Are you actively engaged? 2) Verbal ticks - Do you find yourself saying "um" or "so" or other filler words often? How is your pace? Are you speaking too fast? 3) Structure -Did you follow the structure above? Did it flow well or feel unnatural? 4) Content - Did you like the examples you used? Is there something stronger?



When you are finished with your self reflection, take a day or two to break and integrate your notes, then come back and try again and see where you have improved and where there might be more refining to do.



Throughout your time at Flex Air, one of the primary pillars of your experience will be career development exercises such as this. We believe this attention to detail and student support can really make all the difference.


